




Our Heritage

Overlooking Romney Marsh and the English Channel, the historic Grade II* listed Port Lympne Mansion is surrounded by 600 acres of magnificent private parkland. For over a century, Port Lympne has entertained royalty, aristocracy, prominent politicians and playwrights.

Throughout the roaring 20s, notable guests included Charlie Chaplin, the Prince of Wales, Lord Mountbatten, Sir Winston Churchill and T.E Lawrence. The mansion's library was refurbished to serve as a venue for the signing of treaties and The First Lympne Peace Conference was held at the mansion in 1920. Attendees included UK Prime Minister, David Lloyd George; French Prime Minister, Alexandre Millerand and a contingent of highly-influential ministers and military figures.

Regarded as one of England's finest country houses, Port Lympne offers a truly exceptional venue for your meeting or event, with unforgettable backdrops steeped in a golden era.





The Mansion

Historically a gathering place for pivotal figures in the art world, high society and politics of the day, the Cape Dutch-style mansion was built for Sir Phillip Sassoon in 1913 by architects Sir Herbert Baker and Philip Tilden.

We offer the use of the stunning drawing rooms and terraces, surrounded by glorious landscaped gardens, providing the perfect backdrop for your event. These include The Long Room, The Spencer Roberts Room and The Martin Jordan Room.

The strikingly original decor within the mansion is enhanced yet more by spectacular sea views from the south and west-facing terraces.



The Long Room

In the heart of the mansion, The Long Room blends opulent country-house tradition with the exotic tastes of former owner Sir Philip Sassoon, who commissioned its striking hand-painted animal murals. With capacity for 35 people boardroom-style or up to 50 lunch/dinner-style on round tables, The Long Room is the ideal space for larger meetings and training events or private dining. A state-of-the-art AV set-up, including screens, projectors and a sound system is available, with access to the beautiful Southern Terrace to bring the outside inside.

The Spencer Roberts Room

Decorated with Arthur Spencer Roberts' stunning hand-painted animal murals, this room offers a cosy yet flexible space in the heart of the mansion.


Animal Encounters

HOW TO REACH US

Port Lympne Hotel & Reserve is located in the South East of England in the beautiful county of Kent, and is within easy reach of London, Surrey, Sussex, and Essex.

By Car:

Take Junction 11 off the M20 and follow the brown tourism signs to the park.

By Train

Ashford International is 15 mins away and provides high speed rail services to London St Pancras (35 min) and Paris (1.5 hours).

By Air

Both Gatwick & Heathrow Airports are within a 1.5 hour drive. For those wishing to arrive by helicopter we have our own helipad onsite.
